**Pilgrims of Hope Journey** 

Pope Francis has declared 2025 a Jubilee Year, specifically designated as the year of "Pilgrims of Hope." This Jubilee Year invites us to engage in prayer and reconciliation, encouraging us to remain a faithful community of believers filled with hope. Jubilees occur only every 25 years and provide a special opportunity for each of us to draw closer to God and to our neighbors.

Bishop Daniel E. Thomas has designated four locations in the Diocese of Toledo as Jubilee Pilgrimage Sites:

- Our Lady, Queen of the Most Holy Rosary Cathedral (Toledo)
- The Sorrowful Mother Shrine (Bellevue)
- Our Lady of Hope Catholic Church (Attica)
- The Basilica and National Shrine of Our Lady of Consolation (Carey)
- O Sorrowful Mother Shrine and Our Lady of Hope Wednesday, June 4

We will depart Holy Trinity at 10:00am for Mass at 11:00am and a tour of the Shrine from 12:00-2:00pm. On the way back through, we will stop at Our Lady of Hope for a quick visit and time for prayer in their church.



**BE BOLD** *Ephesians 3:12*
